Students will work in small groups to select a theme and put together a short video piece that will be screened at the end of the week. July 16-27: THE STREET ART PROJECT

The Street Art Project (SAP), now in its 2nd year, offers youth an opportunity to make art that will be displayed in public spaces around town. Sample projects include wheat paste, found object sculpture and interactive community photos. We will focus on sending a message through our art interventions in the public sphere. SAP encourages both individual and group products, and explores radical ideas about the nature of art.
